



God has established government for the good of all people



What truths are taught about governments and rulers?

Proverbs 16:9, 33 – "A man's heart plans his way, but the LORD directs his steps....The lot is cast into the lap, but its every decision is from the LORD.

Proverbs 21:31 - "The horse is prepared for the day of battle, but deliverance is of the LORD."

Isaiah 40:22-24 – "It is He who sits above the circle of the earth, and its inhabitants are like the grasshoppers, who stretches out the heavens like a curtain, and spreads them out like a tent to dwell in. He brings the princes to nothing; He makes the judges of the earth useless. Scarcely shall they be planted, scarcely shall they be sown, scarcely shall their stock take root in the earth, when He will also blow on them, and they will wither, and the whirlwind will take them away like stubble."

What responsibility do we have towards our government?

Romans 13:1-7 - "Let every soul be subject to the governing authorities, for there is no authority except from God, and the authorities that exist are appointed by God. Therefore whoever resists the authority resists the ordinance of God, and those who resist will bring judgement on themselves. For the rulers are not a terror to good works, but to evil. Do you want to be unafraid of the authority? Do what is good. But if you do evil, be afraid; for he does not bear the sword in vain; for he is God's minister, an avenger to execute wrath on him who practices evil. Therefore you must be subject, not only because of wrath but also for conscience' sake. For because of this you also pay taxes, for they are God's ministers attending continually to this very thing. Render therefore to all their due: taxes to whom taxes are due, customs to whom customs, fear to whom fear, honor to whom honor."

What responsibility do we have towards our government? (continued)

I Timothy 2:1-4 – "Therefore I exhort first of all that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks be made for all men, for kings and all who are in authority, that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence, For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth."
