PATRIARCHS OF THE PROMISE Lesson 13: God Blesses Joseph



Romans 8:28 And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose. (ESV)

Genesis 39:1-20, Observation

- Potiphar, captain of the bodyguard
- "Yahweh was with Joseph"
- Joseph is successful everywhere, given authority
- Potiphar's wife tries to lead Joseph into adultery
- Joseph's reply, safeguarding actions
- She seizes his garment, Joseph flees
- Joseph slandered as rapist, thrown into special prison



Genesis 39:1-20, Interpretation

- Why does God bless Joseph in Potiphar's house?
- How do Joseph's actions with Potiphar's wife illustrate righteous principles given elsewhere in the Bible?
- Why wasn't Joseph executed for his "crime?"

Genesis 39:21-40:23, Observation

- "Yahweh was with Joseph"
- Joseph is successful everywhere, given authority
- ► Two officials with dreams
- Cupbearer will be restored to position in three days
- Joseph's request for remembrance
- Baker will be executed in three days
- Joseph's interpretations prove true, but he is forgotten



Genesis 39:21-40:23, Interpretation

- How did Joseph accurately interpret these dreams?
- Why did the cupbearer forget Joseph?
- Why was God causing Joseph to suffer?

Application

- You can trust and obey God even when you suffer injustice and even when you cannot see what God is doing because God is at work.
- Are you grateful for all the ways God blesses you?
- How have you been treated unjustly in your life?
 What should be your response?
- ► Have you learned to hate and flee sin?
